Allen and Senator Glazer are co-sponsors of a series of recently introduced bills that would establish a database to monitor students' habits as well as a state-run office to hold higher education systems accountable for their students' performances. Allen has a B.A. from Harvard University, where he graduated magna cum laude in History; an MPhil. from the University of Cambridge, and a J.D. from UC Berkeley. While at Berkeley, Allen served as UC Student Regent-designate from 2006 to 2007 and as Student Regent from 2007 to 2008. For three years prior to his election to the Senate, he was a lecturer on education law and policy at UCLA's Law School.
