Given the competitive nature of transfer admission for the College of Letters and Science, Berkeley requires full completion of the IGETC pattern of courses as selection criteria for admission into the College. The best prepared candidate for admission will have IGETC completed by the end of spring term for fall admission.

Any student offered admission on the condition that they submit full IGETC certification but then submits a Partial IGETC Certification, could have their positive admission decision reversed.

Berkeley will consider students who cannot complete IGETC on a case by case basis.

The best counsel for College of Letters and Science applicants is to complete either the full IGETC pattern or the L&S Requirements by the end of the spring term.
